## - Marshals/Umpires

#### 8. Permission for an Associate in a Senior Division Crew

QCBC would like to request permission for Olivia Lalude-Haworth to cox their W1 boat, which is currently in a senior division (div. 3) in Summer Eights.

Olivia was a regular member of the boat club but this year had to suspend her studies for medical reasons. She is also one of very few coxes at QCBC this year.

Queen's will not enter a W2; as such, their W1 boat will be their lowest boat in a women's division.

## 10. Changes to the Rules of Racing (Eligibility)

## Add rule A1.2.3:

Where a bona fide student or visiting student of college A has competed as an associate member of club B (as defined in A1.1.1d) and wishes to have membership of College Boat Club B, the student may be transferred by the following procedure:

- a. A transfer in this way may only be granted to a student that has learned to row with College Boat Club B as an associate without student status (in accordance with University Statute II), but has since gained student status.
- b. The student must provide to the OURCs Sabbatical Officer:
  - I. Their name;
  - ii. Details of the type of University card they hold, and the number;
  - iii. Written permission of the captains of both College Boat Club A and B. In the event of college A not having an affiliated Boat Club, permission is only required from the captains of College Boat Club B;
  - iv. Proof of academic status, including the finishing date for their course of study. An enrolment certificate signed by the Senior Tutor, or equivalent, will be acceptable.
- c. At the next Captain's Meeting, the OURCs Sabbatical Officer will include a list of transfers requested under this section on the agenda that have been received before the publishing of that agenda.
- d. At the next Captain's Meeting, the captain of College Boat Club B presents their case to the assembled captains, explaining the circumstances of their request and objections can be raised for one of the following reasons:
  - I. The student is not a bona fide or visiting student of college A; or
  - ii. The student was a bona fide student (in accordance with University Statute II) of a different college during their time as an associate at College Boat Club B; or
  - iii. The student had rowed previously to being an associate member of College Boat Club B; or
  - Iv. The student did not compete in an OURCs event for College Boat Club B
- e. If there are no objections, a vote to allow the transfer will be held and passes with a simple majority.
- f. In the event of an objection, the OURCs Sabbatical Officer will resolve whether or not the transfer can be brought under this section. This must be resolved before the end of the meeting in which the motion was raised.
- g. Transfers have effect from the end of the Captain's Meeting at which they are announced by the OURCs Sabbatical Officer. The student will no longer be eligible to row with college A in OURCs events except as an associate member, unless they transfer back to the college where they are currently a bona fide student or visiting student.
