## Rules of Racing A1.1.a.i.1.c:

Members of College Boat Clubs are classified either as:

#### i. Student members

- 1. Bona fide students (in accordance with University Statute II) of their respective college(s), until such time as:
  - a. they leave or suspend their course of study; or
  - b. a pass list or class list marking the end of the course is published; or
  - c .leave to supplicate for the degree is granted. In extraordinary circumstances, this period may be extended to a given date by a majority vote at a Captain's Meeting.

      - Received leave to supplicate on 17<sup>th</sup> April 2019
      - 3 years' experience, but not rowed in the past year
      - Intends to row in the bottom boat.
    - Sam Rowan (LMH) LMH to speak
      - Intends to row in 1st boat
      - Has not received leave to supplicate as of 14/5.

#### 10. Permission to have an Associate in Senior Divisions

Rules of Racing A3.6.iv:

If a College Boat Club's lowest crew for a given gender is in a Senior Division at the start of the competition, specific permission to compete as an associate member in that crew must be given by a majority vote at a Captain's meeting. The Associate Member(s) in question must be named in the proposed motion. All other Associate Member rules must still be followed.
