Please remember:

- Clubs are responsible for sending the number of marshals indicated above. If your club name is noted multiple times, you must send that number of marshals
- If you fail to register marshals on-time, a fine of £10 will be charged. Alert the Race Secretaries before the deadline if you are struggling and need more time
- To be a marshal, you need to have adequate hearing ability in order to work radios.
- Marshals **MAY NOT** hand over to a new shift within 10 minutes of a division start or while a division is still passing by their position.
- Marshals **MAY NOT** leave their posts without permission to do so. They must stay until a replacement arrives or the Senior Umpire dismisses them after the last race of the day.
- **DO NOT** be late - clubs will be fined if marshals are late, do not arrive, or leave early.
- Dress warmly, bring extra clothing, and watch personal belongings carefully.
- Marshals should come to Racedesk (Longbridges Boathouse) to be briefed.
