## Marshals are a vital part of our events - without them, we cannot run races. Please remember:

- Clubs are responsible for sending the number of marshals indicated above. If your club name is noted multiple times, you must send that number of marshals
- If you fail to register marshals on-time, a fine of £10 will be charged. Alert the Race Secretary before the deadline if you are struggling and need more time
- To be a marshal, you need to have adequate hearing ability in order to work radios.
- Marshals **MAY NOT** leave their posts without permission to do so. They must stay until a replacement arrives or the Senior Umpire dismisses them after the last race of the day.
- DO NOT be late clubs will be fined if marshals are late, do not arrive, or leave early.
- Dress warmly, bring extra clothing, and watch personal belongings carefully.
- Bring a watch or other time device set to GMT and checked against <u>https://greenwichmeantime.com/</u> so that race time can be checked accurately.
- Marshals should come to Racedesk (Longbridges Boathouse) to be briefed.
